## **38 YEARS OF HISTORY**

All over the world, only **Rock Master** can boast such a long-standing history and such a renowned name in the sport climbing scene. Since 1987, the Arco event has continuously evolved, anticipating trends in the sport and proposing thrilling formats that attract the world's climbing elite and a multitude of enthusiasts and practitioners to this corner of Garda Trentino.

## **Beginnings**

The pioneering edition on natural rock of 1987 was followed by the construction of the famous Climbing Stadium, still the venue of the event to this day, and several years featuring the combined Lead "on-sight/worked" format and the Speed Parallel races.

#### 2000s

In the 2000s, the head-to-head challenge of the Lead Duel and the explosiveness of the KO Boulder kept the eyes of sport climbing enthusiasts glued to the walls, crowded into the parterre of what is recognised worldwide as the 'Home of Climbing'.

#### **Recent times**

Worth noting is the renovation and expansion of the Climbing Stadium between 2024 and 2025, which has led to an increase in the level and quality of the Arco facility with a new outdoor boulder wall and several indoor training facilities, perfect to prepare during the winter season at what has been, since 2021, the FASI Federal Centre.

#### 2025 edition

In addition to being one of the most coveted and followed competitions in the world of sport climbing, in 2025, **Rock Master** is back with a fresh new look. In mid-October, it will combine the iconic Lead Duel and KO Boulder competitions with a three-day event, including an expo area, partner brand talks, athlete meet-and-greets and lots of great music.

It is time to experience **Rock Master**; it is time to celebrate the Vertical Thrill.

## CLIMBERS WHO CARVED ROCK MASTER (AND ITS HALL OF FAME)

Throughout the long and exciting history of Rock Master, there have been climbers who have left a permanent mark on their careers in Arco, winning multiple editions and carving their names into the event's prestigious hall of fame.

In the **women's category**, Austria's Angela Eiter (AUT) leads the way with six victories from 2003 to 2005 and then in 2007, 2009 and 2012.

Lynn Hill (USA) has five victories to her name, inaugurating the hall of fame in the first edition in 1987 and then winning again in 1988, 1989, 1990 and 1992.





In the *men's category*, Ramòn Julien Puigblanque (ESP) and Adam Ondra (CZE) are the most successful athletes in Rock Master history, with seven wins each.

The Spaniard won for the first time in 2005, repeating his success in 2006 and 2007 and winning again in 2009-2010 and 2012-2013.

The Czech broke Puigblanque's winning streak in 2011 and then wrote his name in the hall of fame for four consecutive editions from 2015 to 2018. The 2021 edition also bears Ondra's signature, who, with his success in 2023, matched the Spaniard's record number of victories.

With the world's climbing elite competing in Lead and KO Boulder duels, the well-stocked Village offering culinary delights and shopping for the latest trends, and a variety of experiences for young and old alike, **Rock Master** 2025 promises three days of Vertical Thrill.

At **Rock Master** 2025, the 16 top climbers will compete for the Lead Duel and KO Boulder titles.

## LEAD DUEL, the spectacular soul of Rock Master

In the Lead Duel, two athletes at a time face two identical and parallel routes with the goal of reaching the stop button first. Between themselves and glory, each climber has 25 metres to cover along the notorious overhanging wall of the Climbing Stadium at maximum speed, in a knockout round where only the most brilliant can compete for the title.

## KO BOULDER, pure adrenaline on every block

The KO Boulder consists of ruthless knockout rounds on blocks of proven technical difficulty, set up by the *Rock Master* route setters on the renovated wall of the Climbing Stadium. The ranking is based on the height reached and the number of attempts made by the top climbers, who, at each round, bid farewell to their less successful teammates to determine the event's podium in a tight final three.

## SIDE EVENTS

Not only top-level competitive events, but also much more at *Rock Master* 2025.

#### **FASI Chronos Clash**

The original FASI Chronos Clash is a new proposal of **Rock Master** 2025, consisting of a speed race featuring the Under 17 and Under 19 categories. The Climbing Stadium is the setting for the event, where the new generation of speed climbers face off in a no-holds-barred competition.

The head-to-head battles along the 15 metres walls are synonymous with speed, precision and responsiveness: there is no room for hesitation, and in a matter of seconds, the competitors battle it out to progress to the next round in a test of heart and power.

#### The Fun Bloc

This no-pressure boulder jam is the perfect occasion for sports climbing enthusiasts to take on the walls climbed by the best of the speciality at the Climbing Stadium, in a cheerful and welcoming atmosphere, where there is still a touch of healthy competition.

The Fun Bloc, powered by AutoIndustriale allows novices, beginners and enthusiasts to climb the boulder blocks in the Home of Climbing.

#### **Rock Adventures**

Rock Adventures animate the three days of Rock Master with a focus on newcomers to the discipline, enthusiasts who want to take risks and the younger generation.





## **Crag Calling**

An experience dedicated to adult beginners to familiarise with the ABCs of sport climbing.

#### THE REGIA OF A SHOW CALLED ROCK MASTER

The Rock Master 20.20 organising committee, led by its new president Stefano Bresciani, and the Garda Dolomiti SpA tourist board, are coordinating, organising and overseeing the preparations of **Rock Master** 2025. With great synergy, the close-knit staff brings the spectacle and excitement of **Rock Master** to life.







For decades, Arco has been the global hub for sport climbing. The stunning locations and favourable climate make the Garda Trentino area the perfect destination for enthusiasts of this discipline.

Back in 1987, on the rocky cliffs below Arco's castle, the first edition of Rock Master took place. Since then, it has left an indelible mark on the history of sport climbing and has become the most eagerly awaited international appointment of the year.

At the same time, Garda Trentino developed, becoming the iconic home of climbing, the world capital of this sport, and forging an unbreakable bond with climbers from all over the world. The greatest champions of the discipline have passed through here, some of them taking their first steps in international competitions, such as the two world icons Adam Ondra and Janja Garnbret. Some have fallen so in love with the place that they have moved here, such as Italian champion Stefano Ghisolfi, who has been living in Arco since 2021.

#### THE CRAGS

Not only Arco, but also the entire Garda Trentino is a magnet for experienced climbers and novices alike. With as many as 24 crags, Garda Trentino is a popular destination for outdoor sports, offering charming days of fun, sustainability, and above all, safety. The walls are suitable for all levels of difficulty, starting from the simplest ones; you can reach 'Excalibur' or 'Erebor', the 9b/+ routes freed by Stefano Ghisolfi and recognised as among the most difficult in the world.

#### **OUTDOOR PARK**

Launched in 2009, Outdoor Park Garda Trentino is a project that focuses on sustainability in sports and outdoor activities, ensuring a vision that reflects the spirit of Garda Trentino. The aim is to offer the best possible sporting experience, while preserving and monitoring the trails, via ferrata routes and crags of Garda Trentino.

The project, unique in Europe, proposes a list of guidelines for good behaviour and respect to ensure that projects are concrete and tangible. To date, Outdoor Park Garda Trentino manages 24 crags, 61 MTB trails, 3 via ferrata routes and 31 walking trails.

#### THE OUTDOOR PARK GARDA TRENTINO RANGERS

With the aim of properly managing the trails in the woods and the mountains of Garda Trentino, the Garda Rangers are professional intervention teams that work daily to safeguard the outdoor heritage of the area, carrying out specific checks and, when necessary, intervening on every trail, crags and via ferrata that falls within the scope of the Outdoor Park. In this way, each trail offers the best possible experience combined with the highest level of safety.





#### **FACTS**

There are **24 crags** within the Garda Trentino Outdoor Park, regularly checked and maintained, with over 700 equipped routes.

**Stefano Ghisolfi,** the best Italian climber, born in Torino and adopted by Arco, is the Ambassador of Garda Trentino.

The athletes of the Italian sport climbing **national team (FASI)** have chosen the Climbing Stadium of Arco as their official training venue.

The **Climbing Stadium** was renovated last year and now has 1364 square metres of climbing surface.

News: work in progress at the **Segrom crag** (Nago-Torbole). It will become the biggest climbing Area in Europe.

**News:** The Castel Madruzzo crag has reopened. An intermediate-level wall that is also **enjoyable in winter.**
