



## **SPECIAL REGULATIONS THE FUN BLOC**

### **Art. 1. DATE**

Sunday, October 4, 2026.

### **Art. 2. SCHEDULE**

9.00 - 12.00

### **Art. 3. LOCATION**

Artificial bouldering wall at the Rock Master Climbing Stadium, Via dei Legionari Cecoslovacchi, Arco.

### **Art. 4. EVENT CHARACTERISTICS**

The Fun Bloc (the "Event") is a non-competitive amateur bouldering event organized by Rock Master 20.20 S.S.D.

These special regulations establish, in addition to the general Rock Master regulations, the conditions that every participant in the Event must fully accept.

The Organizer has full authority over the Event and, by virtue of this, has the right to make any decisions concerning it at any time, particularly for objective reasons (for example, in case of bad weather or other unforeseeable events).

Instructions given by the event staff and public safety officials (police, firefighters, mountain rescue service, etc.) must be followed immediately and without reservation or limitation. In case of non-compliance, the Organizer has the right to exclude the participant from the Event. The event staff will be identified as such by the Organizer and will be authorized to give instructions on the Organizer's behalf.

Blocs: 2 blue problems, 4 green problems, 4 yellow problems, 3 red problems and 1 black problem

Each participant may register and takes part in the Event individually; team participation is not allowed.

### **Art. 6. DURATION**

Each participant has an unlimited number of attempts within a total time of 180 minutes.

### **Art. 7. RESULTS**

The Event is amateur and non-competitive; no official rankings will be published. However, the event's official website will list all participants along with the number of problems completed (based on *tops reached* — zones do not count).

The list will be compiled based on self-certification provided by the participants. Jam format competition, where athletes may attempt each boulder in any order and at their own pace within the allocated climbing time.

### **Art. 8. REGISTRATION**

Registrations are open until 10:00 a.m. on October 4, 2026, or until all spots are filled.

Online registration must be completed through the official website by filling in the registration form and providing the following information: first name, last name, date and place of birth, address, e-mail, phone number.

Registration is considered complete only after payment has been received by the Organizer.

#### **Art. 9. FITNESS – HEALTH – WAIVER**

Upon registration, each participant must specifically approve and sign the liability waiver after having carefully read it and this regulation.

Each participant must also provide a copy of a non-competitive medical certificate for sport climbing, to be sent via email to [rockmaster@rockmaster.com](mailto:rockmaster@rockmaster.com).

The minimum age for participation is 15 years.

Participants under 18 years of age must provide a signed consent form from a parent or legal guardian.

#### **Art. 10. PARTICIPATION FEE**

The registration fee is €25.00.

The fee includes: a personalized bib number, the self-certification form for completed problems (based on tops reached), the official event T-shirt, and a goodie bag with items provided by partners and sponsors.

All materials must be collected at the Climbing Village info point during opening hours indicated on the official website, and in any case no later than 10:30 a.m. on October 4, 2026.

#### **Art. 11. WITHDRAWAL**

If a registered participant is unable to take part, the registration will not be valid for the next edition, and the fee will not be refunded by the Organizer.

The purchase of any cancellation insurance remains the sole responsibility of the participant.

#### **Art. 12. EVENT CANCELLATION**

The Event will take place under any weather conditions that do not compromise the safety or health of participants and may be suspended at the Organizer's discretion.

If, due to force majeure, the Event cannot take place, the participation fee will neither be refunded nor transferred to the following year.

All relevant details will be made available online or on-site during the event.

#### **Art. 13. CHANGES**

The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to these regulations at any time.

The website (<https://rockmaster.com/it>) is the official information channel for the Event, as established by the Rock Master General Regulations.

Therefore, all official communications will be published on the website.

#### **Art. 14. DATA PROTECTION**

By submitting the online registration form, the participant declares that they have carefully read and unconditionally accepted this regulation and the Rock Master General Regulations.

Pursuant to Art. 13 of EU Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR), the participant acknowledges having read the privacy notice available on the official Rock Master website and having provided consent through the appropriate checkbox on the registration form.

Failure to provide consent will make it impossible to complete the registration.

By giving consent, the participant authorizes the Organizer to process their personal data in accordance with the General Regulations.

"Processing" refers to any operation involving personal data (e.g., collection, storage, use, transmission, or deletion), including automated means, as provided by Art. 4 of EU Regulation 679/2016.

The participant also authorizes the use of their image (photos, videos, audio recordings) for promotional purposes related to the Event, both internally and externally (publications, sports videos, website, digital channels).

Images may depict the participant individually or in groups, during activities promoted by the Organizer.
